

Fabio Capanni is Full Professor of Architectural and Urban Design at DIDA, the Department of Architecture of the University of Florence, where he received his PhD in 2000.

From 1st January 2019 he's Dean of the Faculty of *Scienze Applicate* at the Catholic University "Nostra Signora del Buon Consiglio" in Tirana.

He taught *Distribution Features and Sacred Ornaments Design* in the Master in *Theology and Architecture of Churches* at the Theological University of Central Italy. He is a member of the Scientific Committee of the *Identity of Italian Architecture* congress that takes place annually in Florence. In 2009 he founded, with Paolo Zermani, the *Italian Architecture Gallery* in Florence.

He has collaborated with the international magazine *Materia* and was editor of the international magazine *Area*; at present he is a member of the Scientific Committee of *Firenze Architettura*, a magazine published by the Department of Architecture of the University of Florence. He is the author of: *Architettura moderna a Fiesole (Modern Architecture in Fiesole)* (Becocchi, 2003); *Di alcune figure e caratteri dell'edilizia residenziale in Toscana, nell'orizzonte della sostenibilità (Some Figures and Characters of Residential Building in Tuscany, in the Context of Sustainability)* (Noèdizioni, 2008); *Spazio, Luce, Architettura (Space, Light, Architecture)* (Noèdizioni, 2009); *La forma della luce (The Shape of Light)* (Noèdizioni, 2015); *Architettura e Luce (Light and Architecture)* (LetteraVentidue, 2017) and several articles and papers. His works have won awards and been published in leading national and international journals.

He is co-founder of *ReThink Daylight*, an initiative to promote the role of daylight in architectural projects promoted by Velux S.p.a.

He's scientific manager of the international workshop *Spazio, Luce, Architettura* promoted by *casabella Formazione* which had as lecturers: Manuel Aires Mateus, José Ignacio Linazasoro, Jesus Leache, Alvaro Siza, Francesco Dal Cò, Federico Bucci, Marco Mulazzani, Maria Bonaiti. He has been counselor of the European University Institute in Florence.
