**Admission to Single Cycle Master's Degree Courses in Medicine and Surgery in English language  
2025 -2026 A.Y.**

The degree course of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery takes place in English Language.

**Art. 1 – Available slots and admission criteria**

The available slots for the 2025 -2026 academic year, for candidates from NON-EU countries, for each course are the following:

Degree Course	Available slots
Single-cycle Degree Course in <i>Medicine and Surgery</i>	20

Non-EU countries applicants who have completed upper secondary education and meet the following requirements can apply for admission:

- They must have an Upper Secondary Education Diploma.
- They must meet the average grade requirement defined in the Council of Ministers' Decision No. 436 of 03/06/2020, as amended by DoCM No. 46 of 01/27/2021 of the Republic of Albania for the academic year 2025-2026, following which the average grade of upper secondary education results **must be equal to/above 6.5** (referring to the Albanian education system);
- They shall not be simultaneously enrolled in other study programs in the same academic year, at public and/or private universities, Albanian and/or foreign.

The selection of candidates will take place through admission tests, which comprise the following:

1. Written test in English, a multiple-choice questions test, to evaluate the applicants' knowledge in Sciences (Biology, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics)	30 points
2. Written Test on English language knowledge	20 points
3. Evaluation of the average grade of the curriculum of the upper secondary school.	30 points
<b>Total</b>	<b>80 points</b>

The admission tests will take place in the headquarters of the Catholic University "Our Lady of Good Counsel" at Rr. "Dritan Hoxha", Tirana, Albania, on the following dates:

Participants in the admission tests must present themselves at the Didactic Secretariat at least 30 minutes before the start of the respective test with an identification document (identity card/passport). You are not allowed to bring electronic communication tools (cell phones, iPhones, iPads, etc.) with you during the test. Participants found in their possession will be immediately excluded from the competition procedure.



## **Art. 2 – Submission of the admission application**

With regards to registration and participation in the admission test, candidates from NON-EU countries must register online on the University portal: <http://admissions.unizkm.al/#/>, attaching an electronic copy in PDF format (pdf/A scan) of the following documentation:

1. Upper Secondary Education Diploma (if available).
2. The certificate of the Upper Secondary Education Diploma, indicating individual scores (written tests, the interview, scholastic credit, additional scores) that constitute the overall grade of the Upper Secondary Education Diploma. In the temporary absence of the certificate, a stamped and signed certificate issued by the relevant School/High School must be attached, attesting to the overall grade and detailed scores (written test, interview, scholastic credit, additional score).
3. Upper Secondary Education Report Cards of all years.
4. Identity card or Passport;
5. Payment of the €50 fee for the application as follows:

In cash at the University's Student Admission Office, available from Monday to Friday, 08:00 through 16:30.

After submitting all the above-listed documents as well as the payment of the fee, the University will verify the documentation and calculate the average grade for each candidate. This verification is done solely for the purpose of determining enrollment eligibility in the competition. Referring to DoCM No. 12 dt. 30.06.2023 and referring to the Joint Order No. 157 dt 03.06.2025 (ESC- AAN), ESC is the body in charge of the official recognition of the documents and the calculation of the average grade for the equivalence and enrollment of foreign candidates.

Enrollment applications and the related documentation must be submitted exclusively to the "Our Lady of Good Counsel" Catholic University, which has not delegated neither Italian or other national agencies for the collection of the documents and/or for the completion of the admission competitions, which will take place exclusively at the headquarters of the "Our Lady of Good Counsel" Catholic University.

The enrollment status can be checked by accessing a special reserved area on the University portal: <https://admissions.unizkm.al/#/auth/signin>.

Candidates who, after checking the documentation and the average grade, are considered suitable for the purposes of registering for the admission test, **will have to pay<sup>1</sup> the fee required for participation in the admission test of 100 Euro by 17 September 2025**. The payment takes place made using the same methods used for the payment of the 50 euro fee.

The ranking of candidates will be based on the final individual results, following the descending order of the obtained score. The results of the rankings for all the competitions of this call will be published on the website of the NSBC
